to the honored mem - or - i - al of the father of Russia,


Vla - di - mir, our guide; for lo! he was born to the hea - thens,

but came to love Christ Who loved him; and unto Him he hath


ascended with his grandmother Olga. Wherefore, we also

that He grant peace to the world and save our souls.




Both now and ever, and unto the a - ges of a - ges. A-men.
