**Abbreviated Znamenny - Tone 8**

*At Vespers on Forgiveness Sunday, and the 2nd, 4th Sundays (Psalm 68:21)*

**In the 8th tone:** Turn not Thy countenance away from Thy servant, for I am afflicted; quickly hearken unto me. Attend unto my soul and deliver it.

*Verse 1:* From the ends of the earth unto Thee have I cried. (Ps 60:2)

*Verse 2:* I shall be sheltered in the shelter of Thy wings. (Ps 60:4)

*Verse 3:* So will I chant unto Thy name unto the ages. (Ps 60:8)
