Abbreviated Znamenny - Tone 8

At Vespers on Forgiveness Sunday, and the 2nd, 4th Sundays (Psalm 68:21)

In the 8th tone: Turn not Thy countenance away from Thy servant, for I am afflicted; quickly hearken unto me. Attend unto my soul and deliver it.
